



## What is SART?

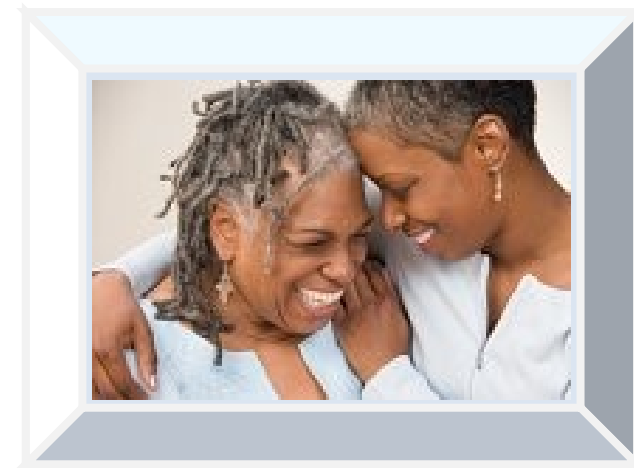
SART is an early intervention program for children ages 0-5 which provides comprehensive assessment and treatment to improve a child's overall functioning. Assessment of the child will identify problem areas in social skills, motor skills, bonding, communication and environmental sensitivities. The treatment team includes psychological counselor, a pediatrician, occupational therapists, speech and language specialists, educational parent partners and personal family support partners.

## What is a Family Support Partner?

West Valley SART Program has partnered with Making A Difference Association to provide Family Support Partners (FSP) to work with families who are in need of additional supports and linkages to other services, programs and community resources.

Family Support Partners are experienced and understanding parents that have successfully navigated complex systems and who have achieved positive outcomes for children who have emotional and behavioral disorders.

Services can be provided in home, at the clinic and in the community where you reside.



## What Can A Family Support Partner Do?

- Support and encourage families going through difficult times.
- Partner with parents to navigate through systems such as:
  - The Department of Children's Services
  - Schools
  - Mental Health
  - Medical
- Meet one on one with your family in the home, clinic and community.
- Support your family at meetings and hearings such as:
  - Court
  - Team Decisions Making (TDM)
  - Individual Education Program (IEP)

## Who Is Eligible To Receive A Family Support Partner?

To be eligible for a Family Support Partner your child must be involved with the West Valley SART Program and/or be referred by your child's SART clinician.
